We are addressing the local issues and have made a positive impact with Anti-Social Behavior in Stanton, Willowbrook, Wolds Drive, Village Hall, Elm Avenue.

Myself, Phil Evans and other members of our team have spoken to all the youths involved on one to one basis over the past few Months. We are seeking long-term solutions by working alongside various agencies. We have held meeting sessions with the youths for their input and ideas. We have the facilities they are asking for to keep hem off the Streets, but we need more people to help in the Youth Centre, either as paid staff or volunteers. If you are willing to assist please contact myself or Linda at the Youth Centre.

The 'Boy Racers' have all been advised (or are on the list to be!), as have all the Scooter Riders to what is acceptable behavior and to giving respect to the Community. Antisocial Behavior is always to be an ongoing project, especially with the warmer weather on the way.

As an update three scooters were taken of the road, some prosecuted and several motor vehicles have also been issued with Section 59 Notices, which mean if they re-offend with 12 months, anywhere in the country, the vehicle will be seized from them – So I would welcome any individual reports from you about any incidents. Please try to obtain vehicle registration numbers and descriptions of those involved.

Parking is a major still issue in most areas. We have made efforts to address the complaints in Tollerton, Keyworth, Willowbrook and Willoughby. Parking around our Schools is becoming more unacceptable with parents parking on pavements, across junctions, on zig zags and contravening parking restrictions.

There are plans for Days of Actions at some of the Schools next term. We will be making a presence at ALL our local schools. Any parking infringement will generate a prosecution, as it is only the selfishness of some drivers that are putting our children's safety at risk. Please park sensibly. We can all make excuses!

Speed checks are planned at various locations: We will be conducting these checks on Nottingham Road, Selby Lane, Church Drive, Bunny Lane, Melton Road, Tollerton Lane, Station Road this Month.
