#### **Keyworth**

8 Crimes.

Robbery at Co-op on 2<sup>nd</sup> at 2130. Staff member assaulted by masked suspects. Nothing stolen. Made off in a blue ford escort. Any information please forward to me.

If you are going away please make arrangements for a keyholder and/or contact details to be left with a neighbour, Neighbourhood Watch or the Police.

Can I reiterate that it is recommended that you do not answer the door to anybody you don't know. Please make use of your door viewer and chain and remember that you can request to see ID should anyone official be visiting your home. If you are concerned then please don't hesitate to contact the Police, use the 999 system in an emergency.
