I've had recent reports of an unknown window cleaner in the Keyworth area acting suspiciously and possibly 'casing' the place? Please make use of your door viewer and chain and remember that you can request to see ID should anyone official be visiting your home. If you are concerned then please don't hesitate to contact the Police, use the 999 system in an emergency.

If you are ringing to report a crime then please phone 0115 9455999 and speak to the force control room. They will allocate your query appropriately.

The health Centre is now open and as is the car park on Bunny Lane. Hopefully this will alleviate some of the parking complaints in Keyworth.
