13 Crimes – a big reduction on last month!

Attempt robbery at Sainsbury's on 2nd. Offenders entered through insecure door just prior to opening. Staff member assaulted, no property stolen. WB CID investigating.

Theft from skip Brookview Drive overnight on 7th. Metal taken. Nothing seen.
