Car crime continues to be a problem all over Rushcliffe South and still the cars targeted are those with property on display within. Please secure items in the boot and take valuables with you. The majority of cases are in Public car parks day and night. Car crime amounts to almost half of all crime on our patch so please be vigilant.

There seems to be an increase in shed Burglary's across the Rushcliffe area. If you would like any crime prevention advise then please contact me or the new Crime Prevention Manager, Pete Ainley based at Bingham Police Station on 0115 9455999 ext 6262. Please stay vigilant and perhaps consider a shed alarm.

I will be holding a Local Area Group Meeting in Keyworth where members of local Parish, Borough and County Council will also be in attendance.

This is your opportunity to raise your specific priorities for the area in which you live to enable us to focus our attention as a group to problem solve your issues. We hold meetings every 6-8weeks. The health Centre is now open and as is the car park on Bunny Lane. Hopefully this will alleviate some of the parking complaints in Keyworth. This includes the undercover area and the disabled bays close to the Police Station.
