It might be advisable to try and make your house look 'lived in' when you are away by using light timers and approaching neighbours to assist with bins and curtains!**

There has been an increase in burglary type offences this last month in the Keyworth area. Now that the nights are lighter and the Sun is shining please remain vigilant. Try not to leave windows and doors open unless you are present. Likewise with regard to vehicles. There have also been a couple of recent incidents involving bogus officials. Do not let anyone into your house that you don't know. Demand to see ID. If you are worried or feel threatened then phone the Police.

I will be holding a Local Area Group Meeting in Keyworth where members of local Parish, Borough and County Council will also be in attendance.

This is your opportunity to raise your specific priorities for the area in which you live to enable us to focus our attention as a group to problem solve your issues. We hold meetings every 6-8weeks. If you would like to attend then please contact me directly, either by mobile, email or visit to the Police Stn.

If you are ringing to report a crime then please phone 0115 9455999 and speak to the force control room. They will allocate your query appropriately.

The health Centre is now open and as is the car park on Bunny Lane. Hopefully this will alleviate some of the parking complaints in Keyworth. This includes the undercover area and the disabled bays close to the Police Station.

The Contact Point, situated in The Square, Keyworth is now open. It is manned whenever Kylie or I are in the Station each day we are on duty. It will also be open every Tuesday between 9AM and 4PM; Friday morning between 9AM and 1PM by Rushcliffe Borough Council and every Saturday morning between 10AM and 12PM by local Volunteers.
